

**Academic Scholarships and Financial Aid
for
Incoming Undergraduate International Students**

Texas Christian University

Two types of financial assistance are available for incoming international students:
scholarships based on academic achievement and need-based financial aid.

Scholarships for First-Year University Students

- \$10,000 to \$42,580 (most awards range from \$10,000 to \$20,000)
- Strong high school grades (typical class rank is top 10-15%, varies by school)
- SAT or ACT required (preferred scores: SAT 1400 or ACT 31)
- Deadline to submit completed application for the fall semester is February 15
- Deadline for the spring semester is October 1

Scholarships for Transfers (*those who have attended another college or university*)

- \$10,000 to \$20,000
- 3.25 (on scale of 4.0) cumulative GPA on at least 27 transferable hours
- Deadline to submit completed application for the fall semester is April 15
- Deadline for the spring semester is October 1

Need-based Financial Aid for First-Year Students and Transfers

- College Board CSS/Financial Aid PROFILE is required (download at <https://profileonline.collegeboard.com/prf/index.jsp>)
- Enter TCU's PROFILE Code 6820
- The College Board will forward results directly to TCU
- Deadline to submit CSS/Financial Aid PROFILE online to the College Board for the fall semester is February 15
- Deadline to submit CSS/Financial Aid PROFILE online to the College Board for the spring semester is October 1

Students should plan to be responsible for the majority of educational expenses, since awards are competitive and usually cover less than half of the cost of attendance. TCU does not offer "full funding" awards. **The average financial aid package is \$20,000 per year and the maximum is \$40,630 (scholarships and financial aid combined). The total cost of attendance is estimated at \$59,370 for 2015-2016.**
